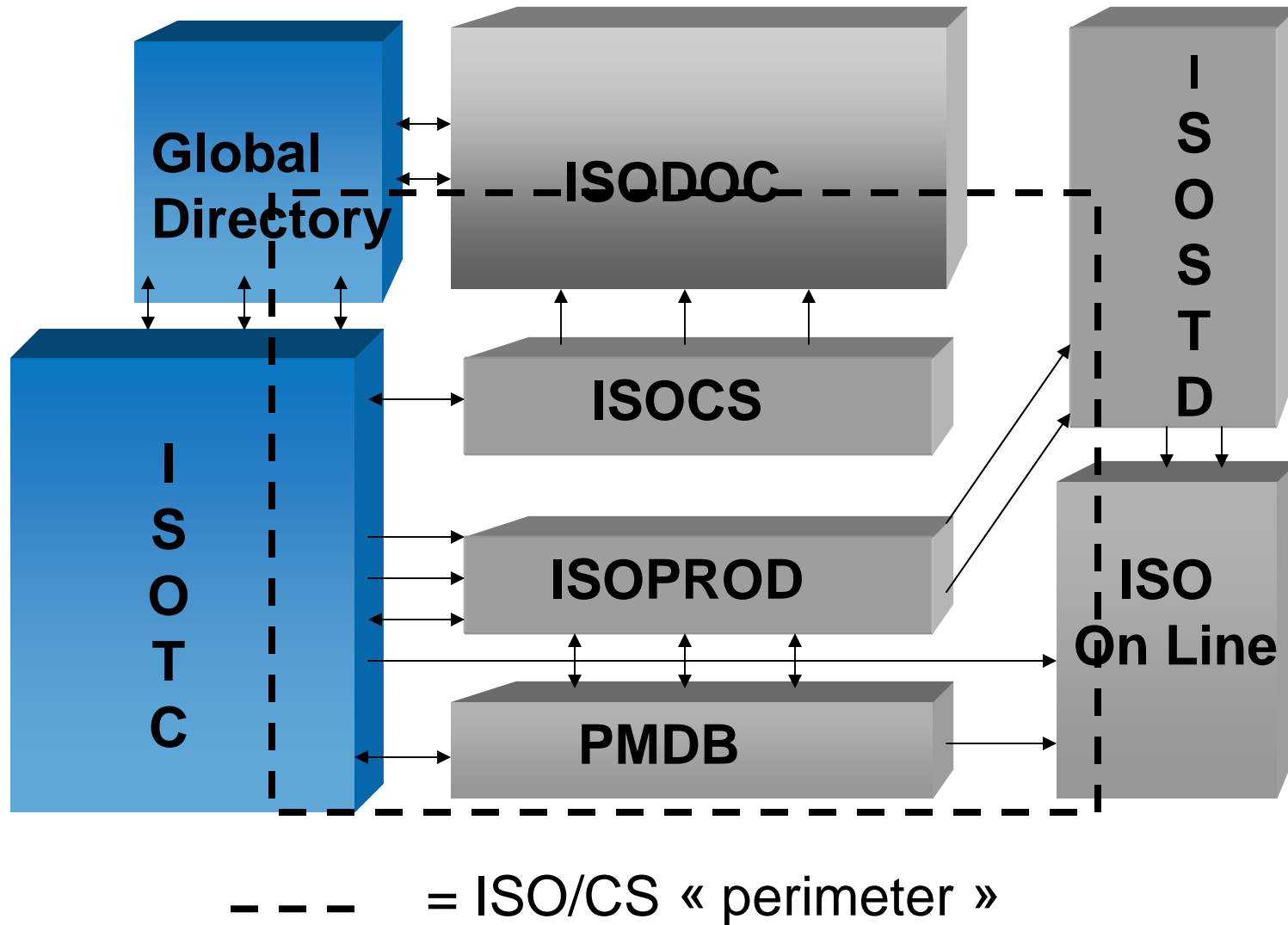

Essential ISO-GD v2.0 Roll-Out Steps

- ISO/CS will initialize the ISO-GD with ISOTC current users and their role assignments
- Regional and central training will take place
- Member bodies appoint one or more administrators who, following comprehensive training, will oversee “their” country
- Organizations holding decentralized functions are empowered by the member body to take responsibility for “their” committees

- **Investigate the integration** between Open Text's eCommittees and the ISOTC server environment
- Design and implementation of services for NSBs to support **National Mirror Committees access** to ISO TC/SC/WG documents
- Implementation of **additional functionalities** supporting committee work:

 - Project management framework
